Student Health Insurance Fact Sheet

The King's College offers American College Student Association health insurance through United Healthcare. ACSA offers a variety of insurance plans for college students. For King's students, we recommend the Domestic High and Low Option plans for New York Residents, both of which give you the option of 12, 9, 6 or 3 month payment terms. Students with a full-time status are eligible for New York Resident coverage through ACSA. For international student insurance plans, please see the United Healthcare website at www.uhcsr.com/acsa.

Plans are available for purchase starting August 1, 2011 and go into effect no earlier than 15 days prior to the student's first day of class (August 9, 2011). A student must take a minimum of six credit hours during the Fall/Spring semesters and/or three credit hours during the Summer semester to be eligible for the plan.

ACSA Low Option

Coverage Overview

- Provided by United Healthcare, PPO. This plan number is 2011-2101-31.
- Up to \$50,000 maximum benefit for each injury or sickness.
- Deductible for preferred providers: \$350
- Deductible for out-of-network providers: \$700
- Most categories of care cover 80% of preferred allowance at preferred providers or 60% of usual and customary prices at out-of-network providers. It is advisable to stay within the network.
- Fixed co-pay: \$25
- Prescription co-pay: \$15-\$50, depending on selection of generic or brand name medication, with \$500 maximum per year (see reverse for more information regarding prescription coverage).

Domestic Coverage Overview

- Provided by United Healthcare, PPO. This plan number is 2011-2101-30.
- Up to \$100,000 maximum benefit for each injury or sickness.
- Deductible for preferred providers: \$250
- Deductible for out-of-network providers: \$500

- Most categories of care cover 90% of preferred allowance at preferred providers or 60% of usual and customary prices at out-of-network providers. It is advisable to stay within the network.
- Fixed office co-pay: \$20
- Prescription co-pay: \$15-\$50, depending on selection of generic or brand name medication, with \$1,000 maximum per year (see below for more information regarding prescription coverage).
